



## Home Learning Year 3

### Week Beginning 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021

#### Remote Learning/ Live Lessons

**This week, children will have the opportunity to join the live lessons at school from home. Here is a step by step guide for how to schedule your learning.**

1. Before you begin your remote education, you should make sure that you have had your breakfast and are dressed for the day.
2. Prepare yourself a tall glass of water and have a pen and paper, and any other appropriate equipment you might need, ready.
3. Click on the zoom links at the allocated times to join the lesson and your class teacher will admit you to the lesson.
4. During the day we recommend that you take part in both the online lessons and try to complete at least 3 subject areas each day. Here is an example of what your timetable might look like for the day:

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5. We recommend that you break your learning up into small chunks, with lots of time away from your computer screen. Use the learning grids provided by your teacher to guide your choice of lessons. Please build in time to exercise. Try to move around as much as possible, stretching your shoulder and neck muscles often. There are lots of 'at-home' workouts that you can try or try the online workouts by Joe Wicks on Youtube.com.
6. Lastly, make sure you are looking after yourself. Make sure that you have relaxation time and fresh air and we look forward to seeing you in the classroom from home.



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#### **ONLINE LIVE LESSONS VIA ZOOM- ZOOM LINKS SENT THROUGH PING TO PARENTS**

We will guide children so they are able to complete the task. Children need to ensure they are ready to learn.

Monday:

1. Login to zoom for 9.10am- E-Safety. Teaching children how to keep safe online. By the end of the session children should be able to identify GREEN, YELLOW & RED websites and APPs.  
After, children will be asked to write down E-Safety rules.
2. Login to zoom for 10.40am for English. Children will be learning how to create a warning sign for Barney (Stig of Dump Character). Plain paper needed.

Tuesday:

1. Login to zoom 9.10am for English. Children will be learning how to describe a scene from the class book Stig of the Dump.
2. Login to zoom 10.40am for History to learn about some of the tools found in the Stone Age.

Wednesday:

1. Login to zoom 9.10am for Stone Age Maths. How did the Stone Age people count? How do we know, log into learn more.
2. Login to zoom 10.40am and let's revise those READING GEMS. Children will revise how to answer questions about books that they enjoy. (Pdf READING GEMS ENJOY can be referred to)

Thursday:

1. Maths- Consolidate 2, 4 and 8 times table  
Login to zoom for 9:10 to start the maths lesson. We will be completing maths sheet 1 during this session. It would be useful to have multiplication grid for this lesson.
2. Science - Types of rocks  
Login to zoom for 10:40 and we will use this session to find out about different types of rocks and how they are formed. We will complete the worksheet-natural and human made rocks.

Friday:

1. Maths - Comparing statements  
Login to zoom for 9:10 to start the maths lesson. We will be completing maths sheet 2 during this session.
2. History/Art  
Login to zoom for 10.40 and in this session children will learn about cave paintings. They will also have an opportunity to create their own cave art. You will need Stone Age Cave Art worksheet. Plain paper, crayons or charcoal or pain are also needed.
