

2 times tables

This week your child is working on their 2 times tables.

$$1 \times 2 = 2$$

$$2 \times 2 = 4$$

$$3 \times 2 = 6$$

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

$$5 \times 2 = 10$$

$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

$$7 \times 2 = 14$$

$$8 \times 2 = 16$$

$$9 \times 2 = 18$$

$$10 \times 2 = 20$$

$$11 \times 2 = 22$$

$$12 \times 2 = 24$$

To help work out the answer, we encourage the children to count in their 2's and write down all the numbers first so they can just count down that number of 2's to find the answer (e.g. count down 5 numbers to get 5×2).
