<p>Go on an autumn walk with a grown-up and collect some autumn leaves. Use these leaves to make a picture or collage.</p>	<p>During the autumn, people often celebrate Halloween. Draw a design for a pumpkin.</p>	<p>Draw or paint a picture of one of the animals in the Little Red Hen story: the Little Red Hen, a sleepy cat, a lazy dog or a noisy duck.</p>
<p>Keep a weather chart for a week. Draw a picture to show what the weather is like each day.</p>	<p>It will soon be Bonfire Night. Draw or paint a picture of fireworks exploding in the sky.</p>	<p>Make a model windmill using cardboard boxes. Talk about the colours and shapes used.</p>
<p>Sammy the Squirrel collected 10 nuts. He hid 6 of them ready for the winter. How many nuts did he have left to eat? You could draw a picture to help you work out the answer. Can you think of any more autumn problems to solve?</p>	<p>In autumn, many people celebrate a good harvest with a Harvest Festival. Write a list of some of the foods that farmers grow on their land.</p>	<p>Practise writing your name forming all the letters correctly. Can you do your surname as well?</p>
<p>Talk about flour and make some bread rolls together. Make and knead the dough, then shape it into rolls and bake them in the oven!</p>	<p>Write some speech bubbles for what the characters say in the Little Red Hen story. Can you write 'Not I' like the animals say when they won't help the Little Red Hen?</p>	<p>Can you find one more/less than numbers to 10? Can you record it?</p>
