<p>Make a list of objects that we use now that the Romans also used. Make a list of objects the Romans used that we don't use now:</p>	<p>Roll a dice 4 times to create a 4-digit number, e.g. 6345. Round this to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. Repeat for 8 different numbers.</p>	<p>Draw/paint a picture of something from Romans times e.g. a Roman banquet, or chariot racing. Write a caption to go with it.</p>	<p>Research a Roman emperor (not Julius Caesar) and create a fact file/poster about them. This can be done by hand or on the computer.</p>	<p>Write a diary entry from someone in a British village which gets taken over by the Romans.</p>
<p>Make a 3D model of a Roman Villa or a Celtic round house from Britain.</p>  	<p>Find as many countries as possible that the Romans invaded. Draw their flags and write a sentence to go with each flag to say when it was invaded.</p>	<p>Bake some Roman honey cakes/biscuits or some spelt bread. Write instructions for how you made them.</p>	<p>Design your own Roman God and name him/her. What were they God of?</p>
