Write some facts about the Romans and draw a picture. This is good website to use: <u>KS2 History: The Romans - BBC Teach</u>	Design your own Roman God and name him/her. What were they God of?	Bake some Roman honey cakes/biscuits or some spelt bread. Write instructions for how you made them.	Research a Roman emperor (not Julius Caesar) and create a fact file/poster about them. This can be done by hand or on the computer.	Create some number sentences (+-X or ÷) using roman numerals for your family to solve. Can they write some for you too? e.g. XII + VIII = XX
Make a 3D model of a Roman Villa or a Celtic round house from Britain.	Find as many countries as possible that the Romans invaded. Draw their flags and write a sentence to go with each flag to say when it was invaded.		Read a book with a historical theme/setting- summarise what the book is about. (This can be written or a video summarising what has been read).	Roll a dice 4 times to create a 4-digit number, e.g. 6345. Round this to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. Repeat for 8 different numbers.
