



You will need:

- Printout of lantern template on white card
- Printout of the brown lantern template on paper
- Printout of ox features template on white paper
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Glue stick



Instructions:

1. To get ready, begin by printing the lantern template on white card. Then, print out the brown paper template. Print the ox features template on paper.

2. Stick the lantern templates back to back so that they line up perfectly and you have a white side and a brown side. Let the glue dry.

3. Carefully, cut off the end of the lantern template that is labelled 'Handle'. Keep this safe for later. It might be a good idea to put your name on it.

4. With the brown side facing you, fold the lantern template in half, lengthways, along the dashed line. You should now see the white side of the template.

Make a Year of the Ox Lantern

- Carefully, cut along each marked line. Don't go too far: stop cutting at the end of each line.

- Unfold the lantern template, then fold it the other way so that you can see the brown side. Open it up again with the brown side facing you. Join the short edges together to and use tape on the outer and inner edges to hold it together. Gently, push down the lantern so that the cut strips stick out.

- Carefully, cut out the ox's eyes and nose.

- Glue the eyes in place (have a look at the finished example to help you).

- Next, glue the nose in place.

- Cut out the horns and ears, taking care not to cut off the tabs, and stick them to the lantern.

- Finally, attach the handle to the inside of the lantern using sticky tape.
