Year 5 - Spring Term

Our Creative Homework Project this Spring term is to do a presentation on an endangered species that lives in the Rainforest.

Children will choose (with the class) which animal they will research for their presentation. To add interest, and to link to our upcoming Science topic on life cycles, we have tried to vary the classification of animals, including mammals, insects, amphibians, birds and reptiles.

The presentation can be handwritten or typed, or can be done as a PowerPoint to be displayed on the interactive whiteboard. It should, of course, include photographs, or pictures, or even a model if they are feeling adventurous! Be as creative as possible!

Facts and statistics about the animal, together with details of how it is endangered, will add interest to the presentation. Most of the chosen animals are on the World Wildlife Organisation's website, where there are facts, videos and photographs to help with research. <https://www.worldwildlife.org/species/directory>
