As part of this term's topic, we will be discussing two of the most mysterious creatures - the Yeti and the Loch Ness Monster. The children will need to research just one of these creatures and find evidence, for or against, whether they exist. Their Creative Homework task is to create a model or a picture of their chosen creature. They will present their model or picture to the class, at one of our Zoom sessions, with their opinion of whether it is real, backing this up with the evidence they have found. Hopefully this will lead to some interesting debates! I am hoping for some convincing theories!

As always, creative homework is designed to excite and inspire children to become independent learners. There is no right way to do this task; every child's project will be unique, depending on how they choose to complete it. Their research work can be hand-written or typed and should be no longer than an A4 sheet. Their models can be made from any safe and suitable material. Their pictures can be sketched, coloured or collage based. My original plan was for all projects to be displayed in the classroom which isn't now possible. However, they could be brought into school for display when we return to school - I will let you know about this. In any event, please encourage your child to be as creative as they can! We will begin the presentations and debates during week commencing 25th January so there is plenty of time to complete them.
