Number bonds activity

Can you practise recalling your number bonds to 10 and then 20 out aloud.
e.g. ask an adult to ask you...

$$3 \text{ (part)} + ? \text{ (part)} = 10 \text{ (whole)}$$

also...

Ask you child to move the numbers around (commutativity)

$$7 \text{ (part)} + ? \text{ (part)} = 10 \text{ (whole)}.$$

The children should understand that the numbers are commutative and as parts, it doesn't matter which order they go in.
