Can you think what materials people would have had to make clothes from around 5,000 years ago?

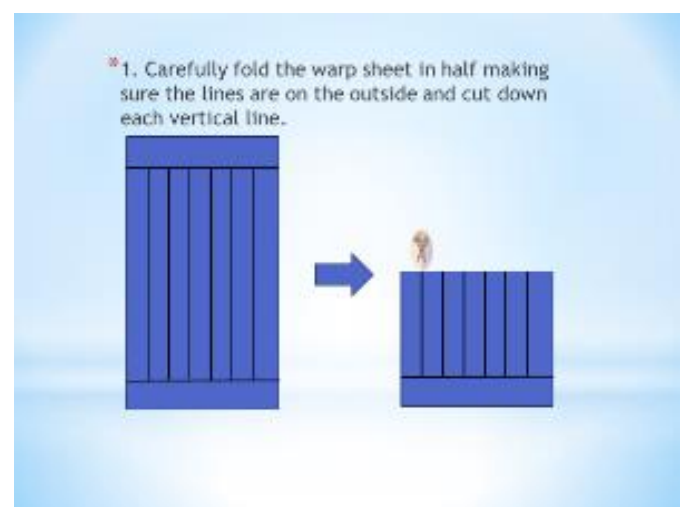
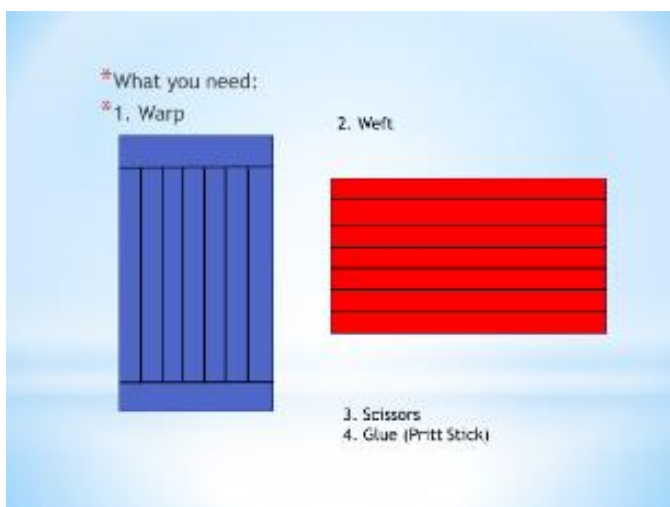
They might have had some of these.

Your challenge

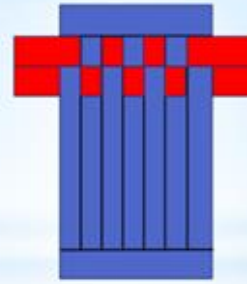
Have a go at weaving. Start off weaving paper in 2 different colours. Use the pictures below to help you. Good luck and remember to be resilient. It may not work first time!!



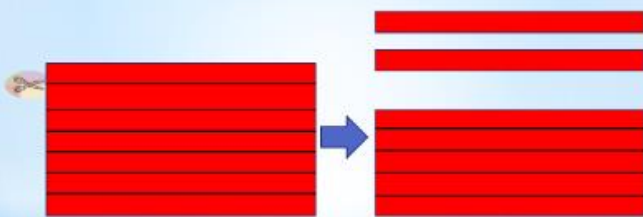
*2. Cut the strips of weft.



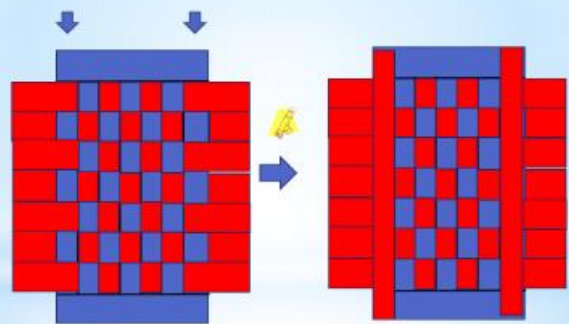
*3. Unfold the warp and weave the weft in.



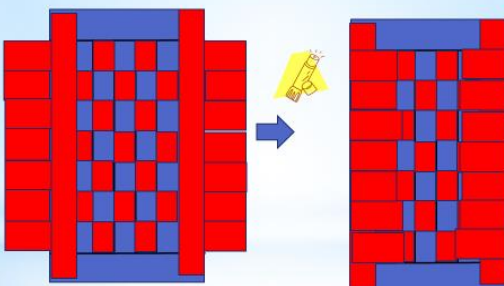
*4. Cut 2 fresh strips of weft from a new piece of paper.



*5. Glue the 2 strips of weft as shown.



*6. Fold back and glue all the overhanging bits of weft onto the new vertical strips. Make sure your folds are neat.



*7. Turn over your weaving. This is the side you look at - with no lines visible and all the overhanging pieces of weft glued behind.
