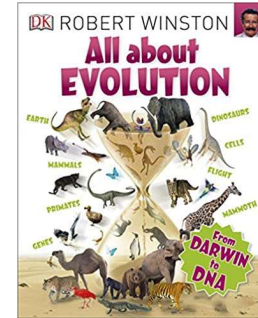


Did we used to be apes?
