*A carnivore!*



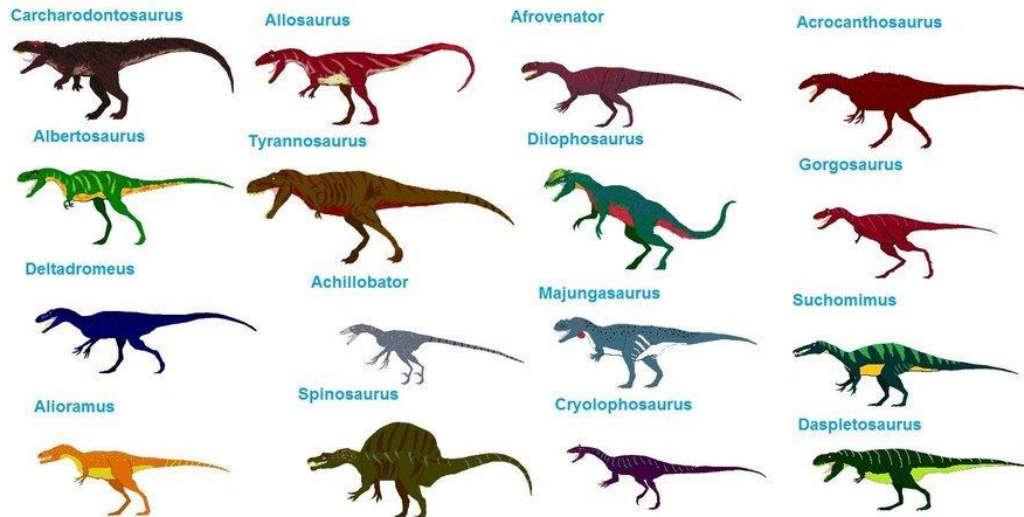
You can tell from it's

Almost all carnivorous dinosaurs also had long, strong legs so that they could run quickly to catch their prey.



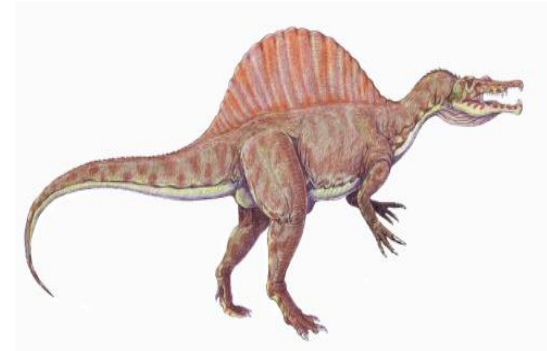
What did carnivorous dinosaurs eat?

Carnivorous dinosaurs ate lizards, insects, other dinosaurs and in some cases, their own species of dinosaur too!

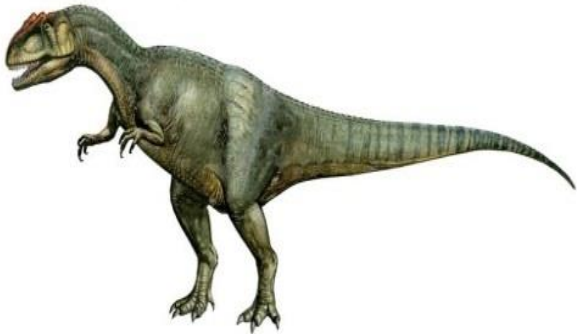

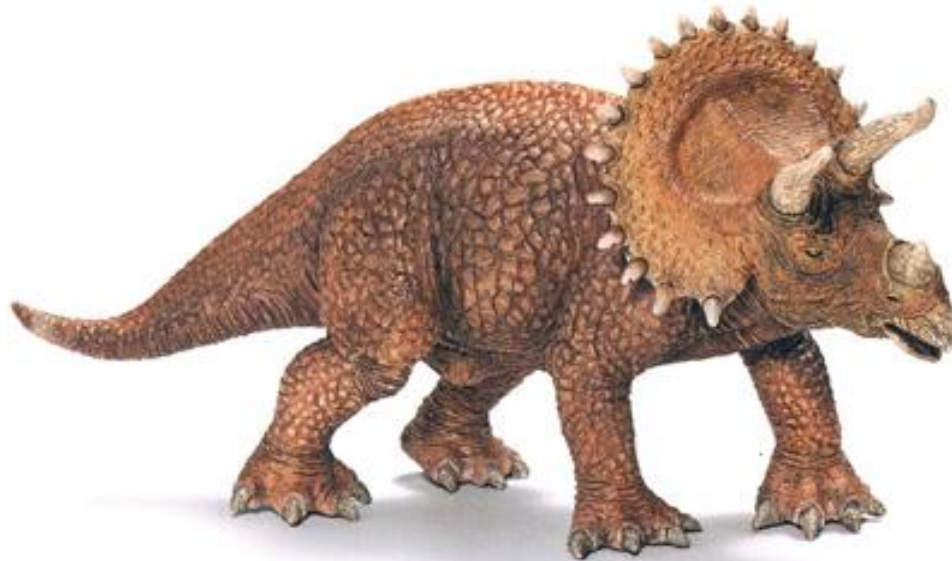
