We've got children who have created their own reading areas in their bedrooms!</p>	<p>Research which flowers are the most bee friendly and do a survey (tally) of your garden and the neighbourhood, how many of these types of flowers can you spot?</p>	<p>Create a poster / fact file / leaflet about different bees from around the world. Focus on one country e.g. Africa.</p>
