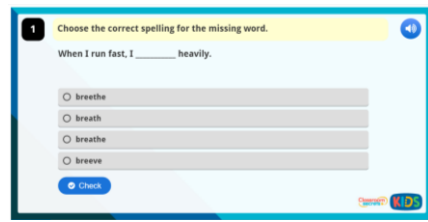

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<p><u>Science and the outside environment</u></p>	<p><u>Invertebrates</u></p> <p>Invertebrates are animals that don't have a backbone. Some have soft bodies, like worms, slugs and jellyfish. Other invertebrates, like insects, spiders and crustaceans, have a hard outer casing called an exoskeleton. This protects their body a bit like a suit of armour.</p> <p>Common land invertebrates can be classified (sorted) into groups.
