Use prefixes and suffixes to write a family of related words around it (e.g. happily, happiness, unhappy, happier, happiest).</p>  <p>Can you use these words in sentences?</p>
Maths and Problem Solving	<p>Follow a recipe to bake some biscuits or cakes. Can you weigh out all the ingredients yourself?</p> <p>Find food in your kitchen, such as tin of beans. Can you find something that is heavier and something that is lighter?</p> <p>Visit MyMaths to complete activities on measurements.</p>	
Science and the outside environment	<p>Log onto Education City to categorise things into 'alive', 'never lived' and 'dead'. Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive by playing the Look Lively game and Abacadabra!</p> <p>Look around your garden or outside to see whether you can find things that are living, once-lived or never-lived.</p>
