

How did Britain change under the Anglo Saxons?

As Artists/ Musicians / Designers we can...

- ✓ Make an Anglo Saxon house (homework task). Use the houses to create Anglo Saxon settlements in class.
- ✓ Make some of the Anglo Saxon artefacts found in the Sutton Hoo, eg brooches, coins, helmets, shields.

As Scientists we can...

- ✓ -Know what gravity is and its impact on our lives
- ✓ -Identify and know the effect of air and water resistance
- ✓ -Identify and know the effect of friction
- ✓ -Explain how levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect

As Readers and Writers we can...

- ✓ Grammar and Punctuation focus: Relative pronouns, relative clauses, modal verbs, converting nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes.
- ✓ Intense focus on Handwriting with opportunities to display children's work. Writing opportunities include:
- ✓ Playscript: Write a new adventure for King Arthur and his Knights. (Focus for girls: female characters Morgan Le Fay, Guinevere, Igraine etc).
- ✓ Narrative: Create a fictional tale about the Sutton Hoo Mask (eg The Legend of the Mask).
- ✓ Poetry: Revisit alliteration, similes and metaphors for effect. Create their own
