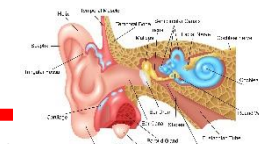


Can you hear me all the way around the world?



As Artists/ Musicians / Designers we can...

- ✓ Make a string telephone and evaluate its effectiveness. Make changes to improve it.
- ✓ Learn to play a Christmas song on the Penny Whistle.
- ✓ Explore Winter landscapes by different famous artists.
- ✓ Continue to learn to play the penny whistle.

As Linguists we can...

- ✓ Learn vocabulary for clothing and use already learnt vocabulary (colours) to describe clothes.

As Sports People on Monday and Thursday we can...

- ✓ Improve our swimming skills
- ✓ Year 4 will be improving their handball skills

As Readers and Writers we can...

- ✓ Create a short dialogue between two children from different countries using the conventions of inverted commas.
- ✓ Write a non-chronological report about a different country with 5 separate sections.
- ✓ Create Sound poems using onomatopoeias.
- ✓ Learn and recite "Twas the Night Before Christmas" for performance at the Carol Service.

- ✓ Empathies with less fortunate children around the world.

As Scientists we can explore States of Matter... Sound

- ✓ How sounds are made
- ✓ Sound vibrations
- ✓ Pitch and volume
- ✓ Find out about Alexander Graham Bell

As Geographers / Historians we can...

- ✓ Explore facts about different countries of the world, eg which continent is it in? Does it have a famous landmark? What is its flag?
- ✓ Research the history of the origin of the continents.
- ✓ Investigate geographical features, traditions and cultures around the world.
- ✓ Know where the equator, Tropic of Cancer, Tropic of Capricorn and the Greenwich Meridian are on a world map;
- ✓ Know what is meant by the term 'tropics'.

As Mathematicians we can...

- ✓ Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using formal written methods
- ✓ Solve addition and subtraction two step problems in context.
- ✓ Understand and use the inverse of multiplication. Complete multiplication and division calculations.
