
Aconcagua



Aconcagua is the highest mountain outside of Asia, at 6959m. It is in Argentina, South America and is part of the Andes mountain range.

The first known ascent of
Aconcagua was by a Swiss
climber Matthias Zurbriggen in
1897, though there is evidence of
Inca civilisation near the summit
so it may have been climbed
long ago.
