

Accept any sensible inference regarding what the shark could be thinking, provided that the answer is given in a full sentence. Answers could include the following themes:

- · Wanting to eat the fish.
- · Loving swimming in the water.
- Looking for something good to eat.
- Thinking about how powerful and strong he is.

Q4: How many fish can you see? Answer with a full sentence.

Accept the answer '8', provided that it is given as part of a full sentence, e.g. 'I can see 8 fish.'

Note: Although the shark and seahorses also class as fish, they are not accepted as an answer unless specifically explained by the child due to their subject knowledge.
