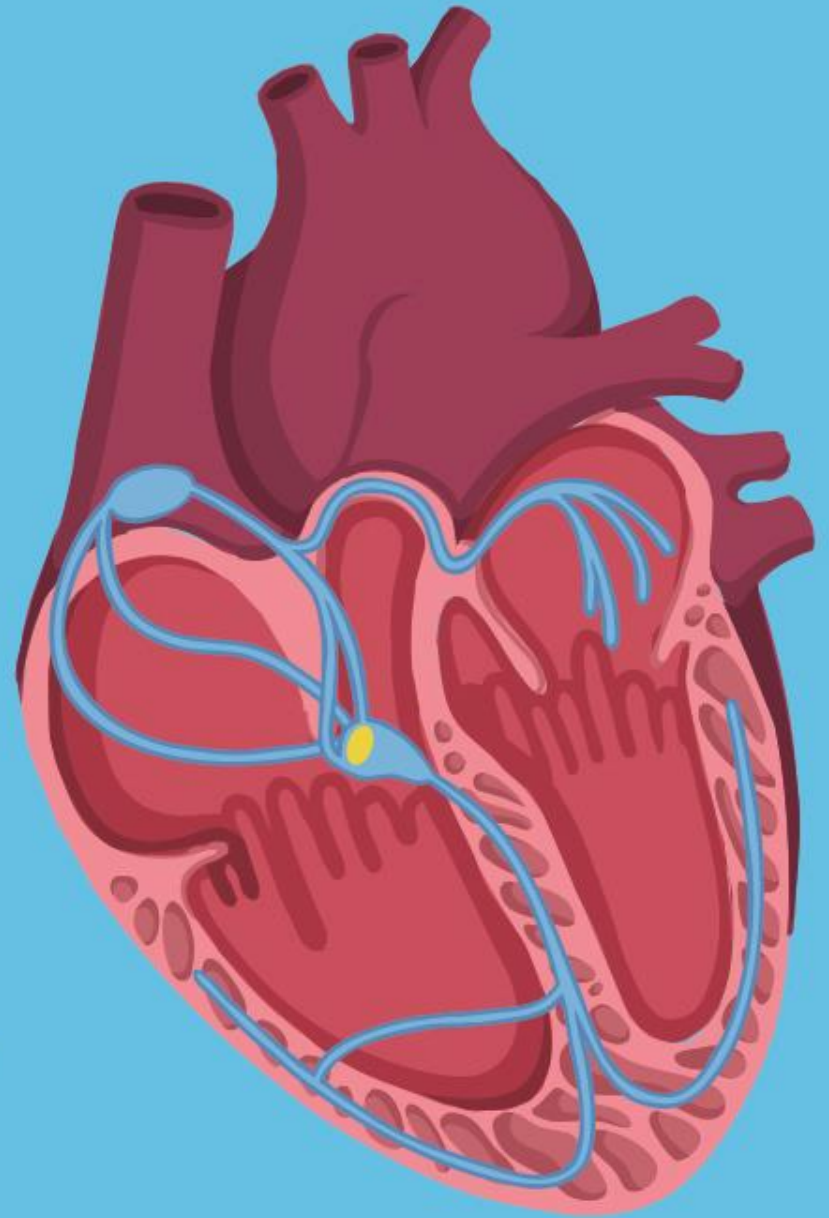


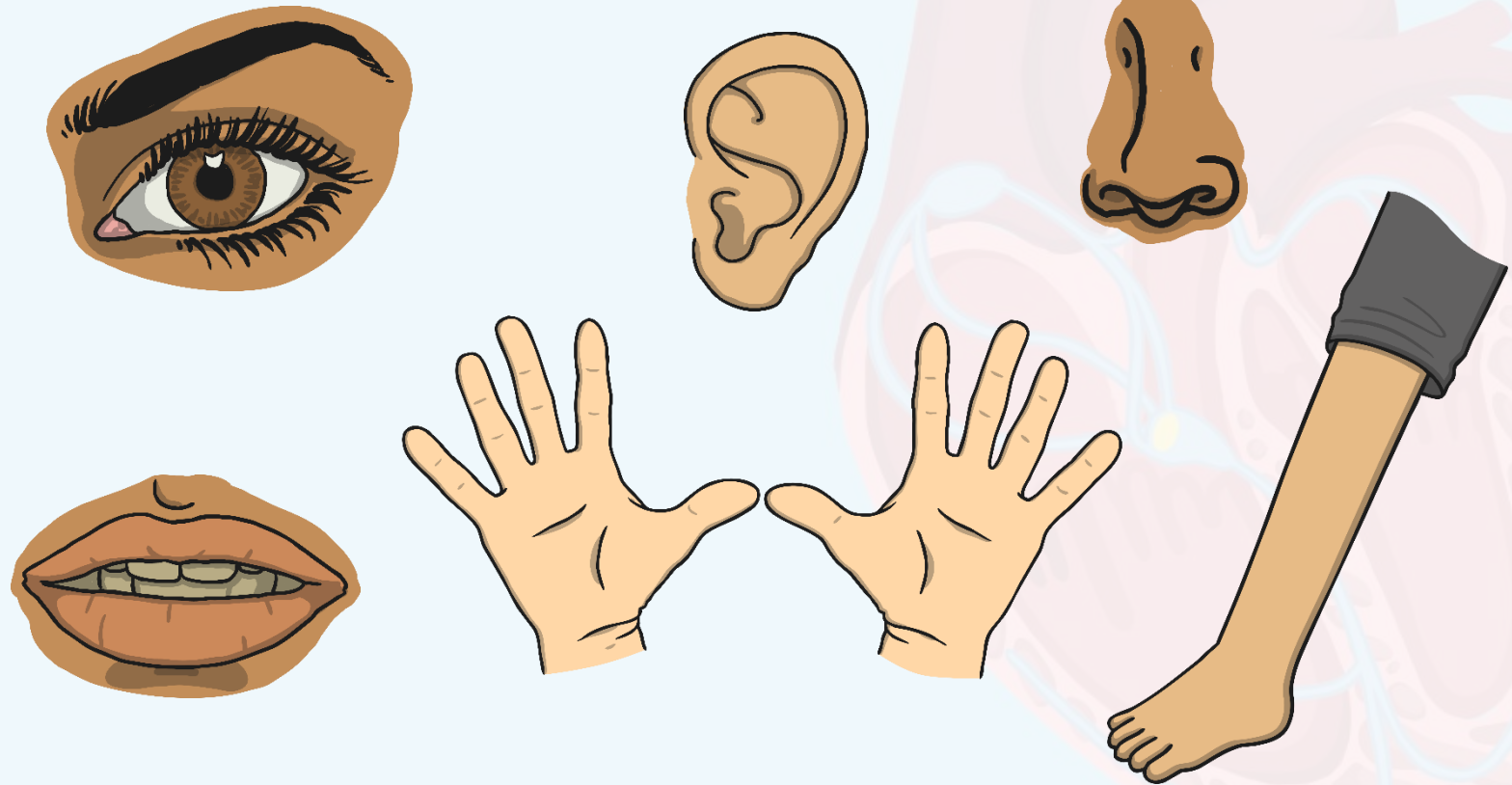

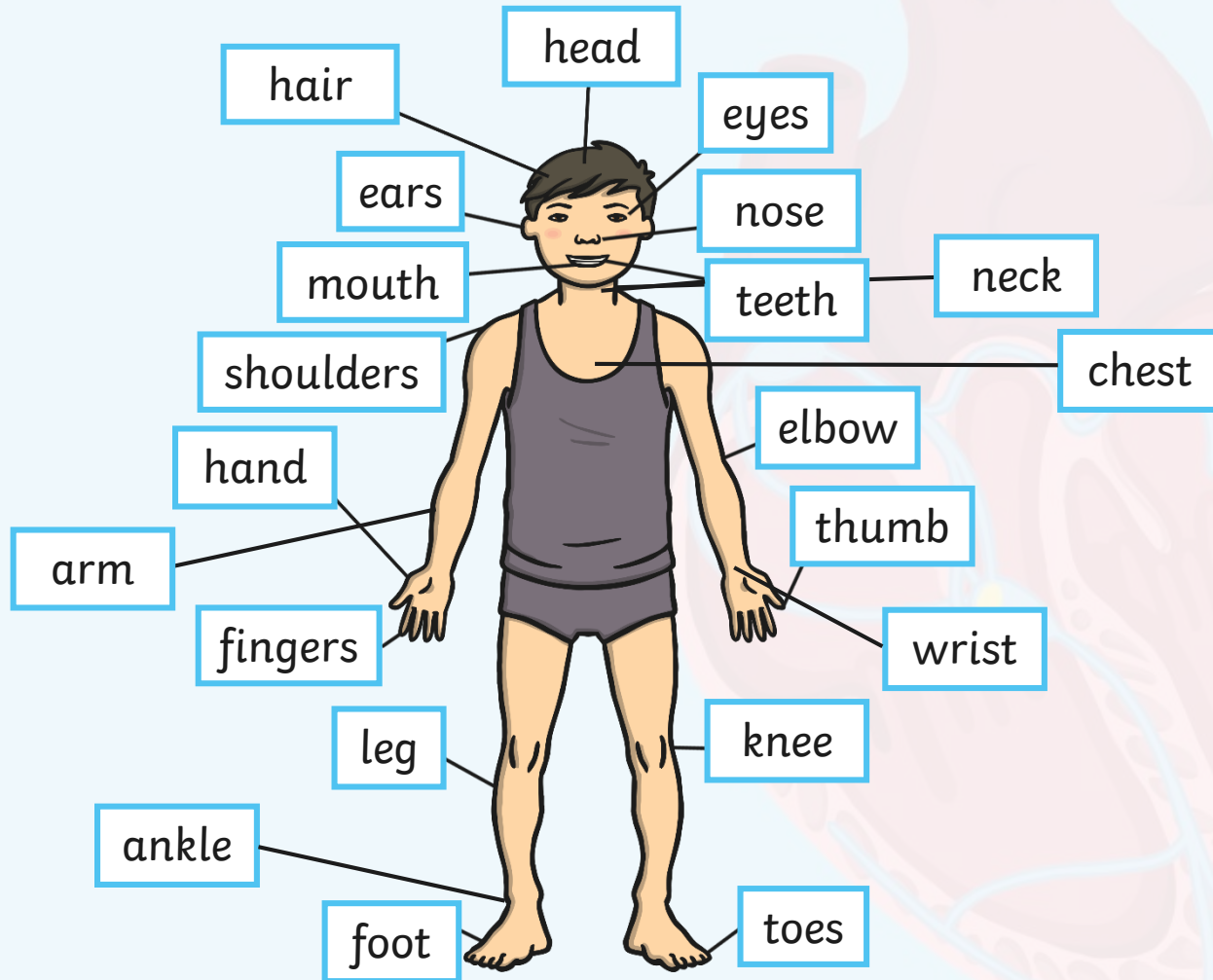


Parts of the Body

Can you name the parts of the body?

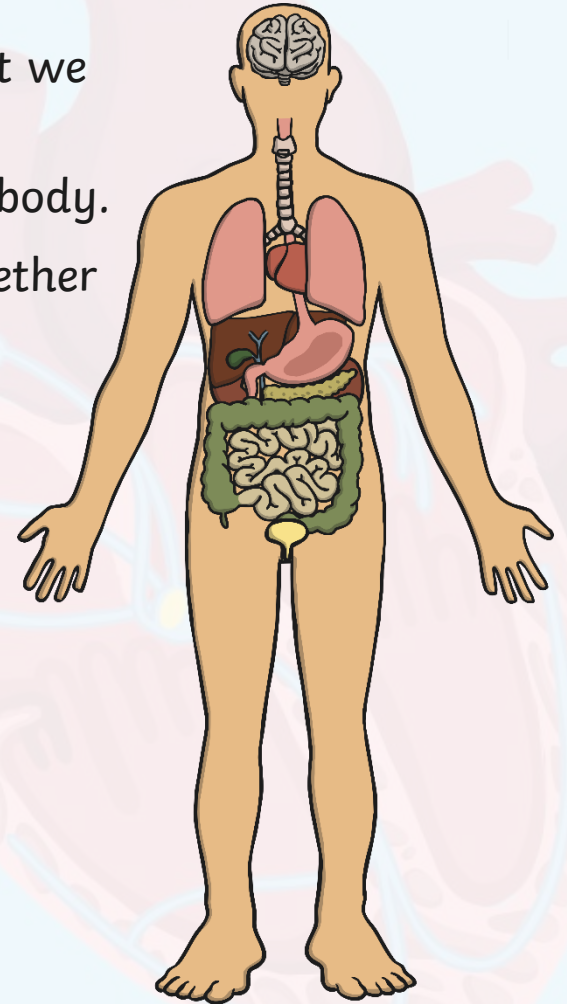
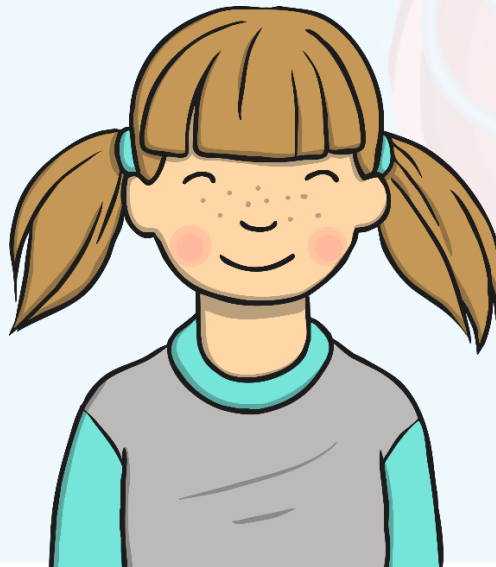
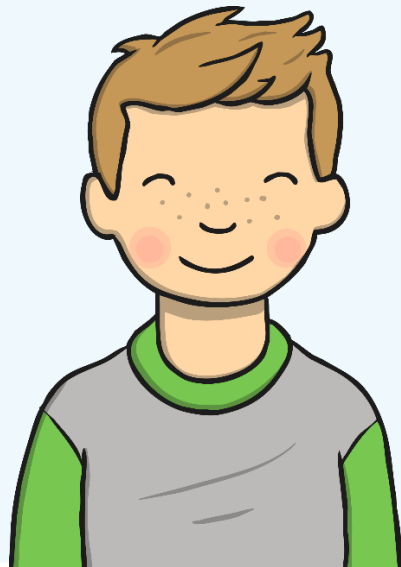


Parts of the Body

They all have important jobs to do and work together to help us stay healthy.



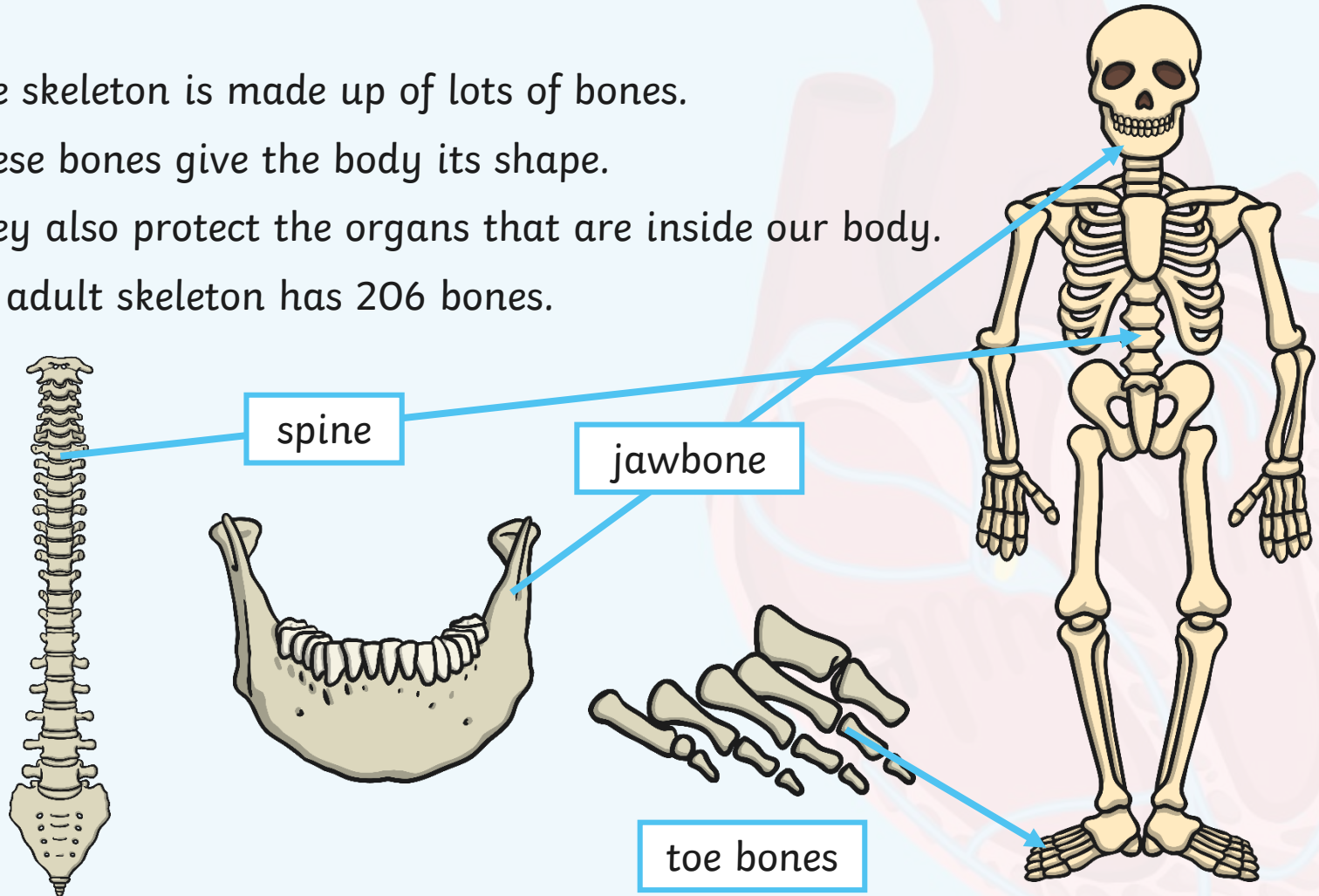
The Skeleton

The skeleton is made up of lots of bones.

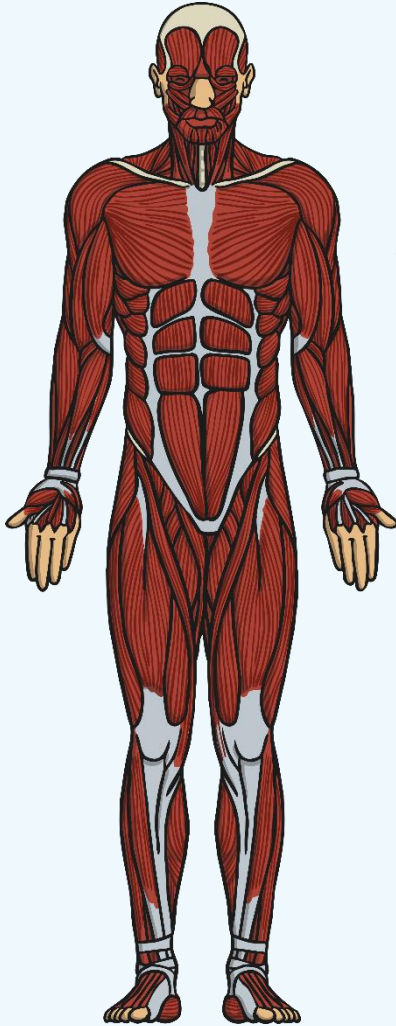
These bones give the body its shape.

The strongest muscle in your body is the muscle in your jaw that helps you to chew!



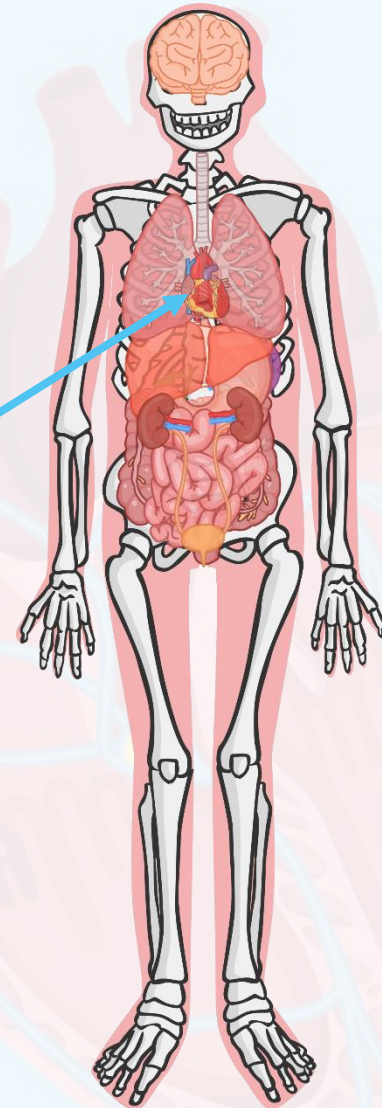
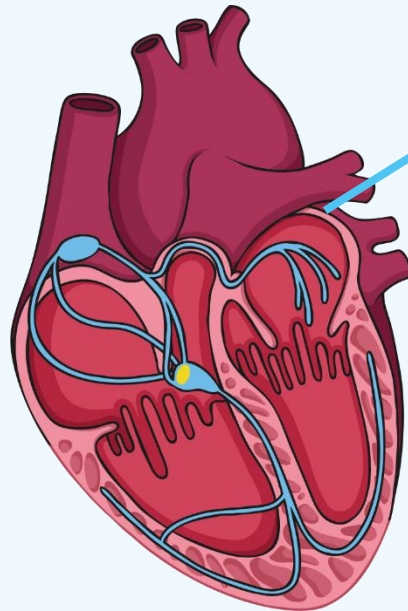
The Heart

Can you feel your ribs?

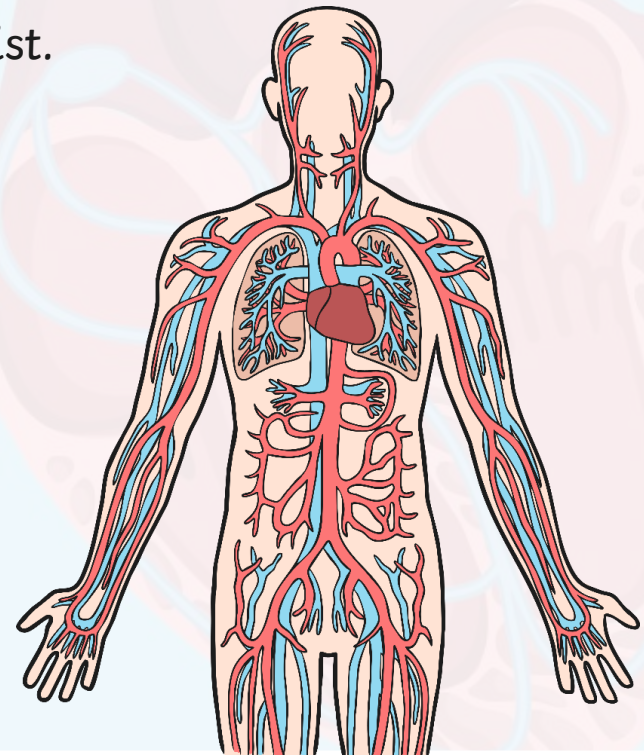
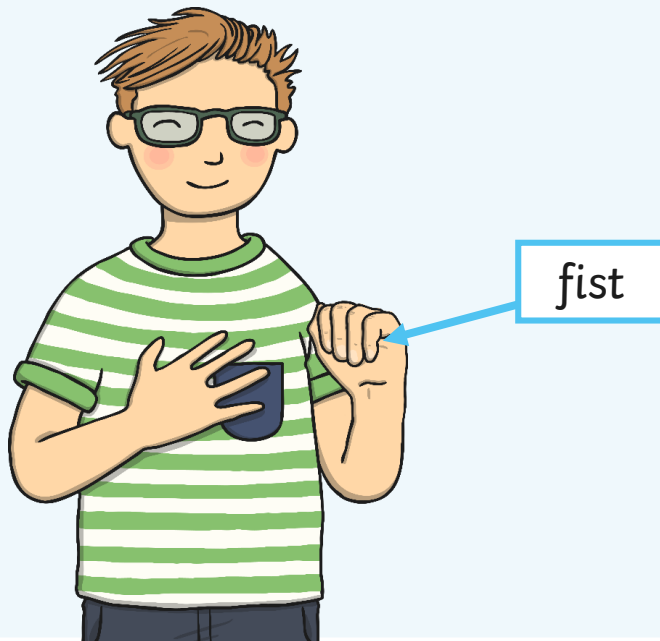


The Heart

The heart has a very important job to do, it pumps the blood all around your body.

The blood takes oxygen from your lungs to all of the different parts of your body.

Your heart is about the same size as your fist.



Lungs

There are two lungs inside your chest.

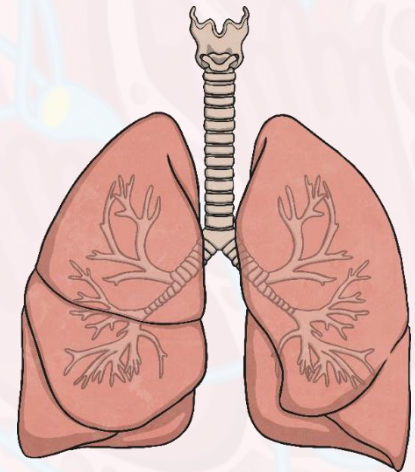
Your lungs help you to breathe.

When we breathe, we take in air.

When you take a deep breath, you can feel your chest getting bigger.
This is because your lungs are filling up with air.

Our bodies use some of the air (the oxygen) to keep us healthy.

Our lungs then breath out the air we don't need.

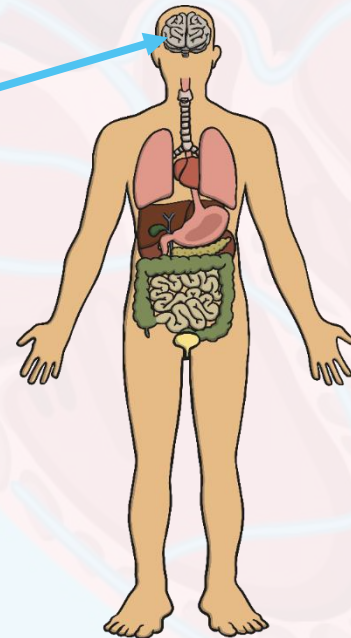


Brain
