## SORTING SHEETS: CHALLENGE 1

## INSECTS

- 6 jointed legs
- Usually have 2 pairs of wings
- 3 body parts - head, thorax, abdomen
- 1 pair of antennae


## SORTING SHEETS: CHALLENGE 1

## ARACHNIDS (SPIDERS)

- 8 jointed legs
- No wings
- 2 body parts
- No antennae


## SORTING SHEETS: CHALLENGE 1

## CRUSTACEANS

- 10 or more jointed legs
- No wings
- 2 body parts - head and abdomen
- Abdomen often has segments (usually 19)
- 2 pairs of antennae (one may be very small)


## SORTING SHEETS: CHALLENGE 1 MYRIAPODS (MANY LEGS)

- Many segments to the body
- More than 14 pairs of legs - each segment has 1 or 2 pairs
- One pair of antennae


## SORTING SHEETS: CHALLENGE 1 MOLLUSCS

- No jointed legs
- No wings
- Soft body with no segments
- Muscular foot
- Most have shells


## SORTING SHEETS: CHALLENGE 1

## WORMS

- Segmented bodies
- No legs
- No antennae
- Usually have bristles although they may be too small to see
