<p>Make a weather chart to show what the spring weather is like each day. You could cut out the weather pictures from the second sheet to stick on your chart, or you could draw a picture of the weather each day.</p>	<p>Hetty the Hen had 10 eggs. On Monday 4 eggs hatched into chicks. How many eggs were left in Hetty's nest? You could draw a picture of the eggs to help you work out the answer.</p>	<p>Draw a picture and label all the animals you would find in the African Savannah.</p>
<p>Read an animal story with a grown up and talk about the setting. Was it set in the jungle? Where was it set?</p>	<p>Design an animal mask of your favourite jungle animal.</p>	<p>Can you draw a long snake shape and then create a repeating pattern that goes all the way from its head to its tail?</p>
<p>Find out 3 facts about a jungle animal that you can share with the class. You could look in a book or on the internet. (Ask a grown up to write them down for you to help you remember).</p>	<p>Draw a picture of an animal that uses camouflage to hide.</p>	<p>Use your phonics skills to help your grown-up write a shopping list.</p>
