







<p>Write 4 sentences about your favourite toy and other members of your family's favourite toys when they were little. Can you use 'because' to explain why it was their favourite?</p>	<p>Create a marble run.</p> <p>Here is an few examples:</p>    <p>LEGO Marble Run</p>	<p>Learn to spell the days of the week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.</p> <p>Your child will be tested on these before the end of the academic year.</p>	<p>Practise identifying coins and notes by selecting different amounts for them to put in bun cases.</p> <p>To keep this simple, put the value of one coin/note e.g. 50p or £10.
