

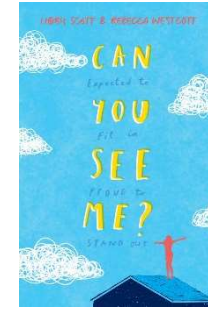
What makes you unique?
