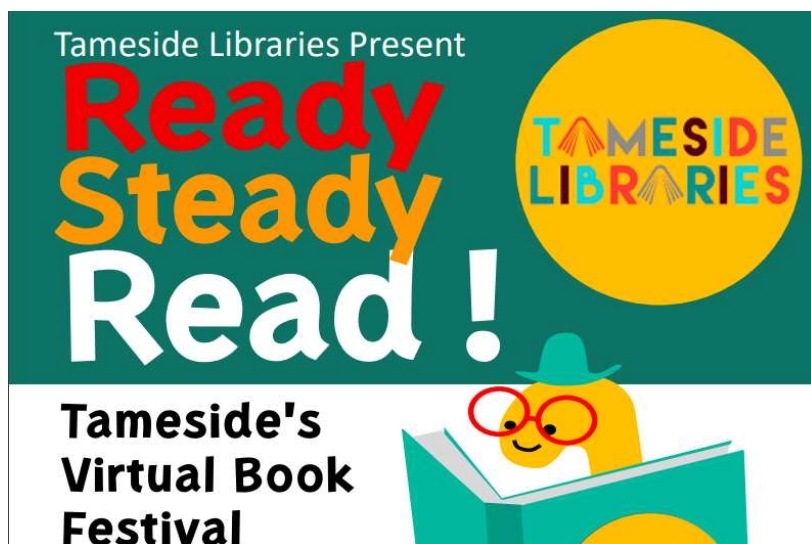


Events for World Book Day 2021
