Remote Learning/ Live Lessons

Monday 25th Jan - Friday 29th

This week, children will have the opportunity to join the live lessons at school from home. Here is a step by step guide for how to schedule your learning and get the most out of this experience.

1. Before you begin your remote education, you should make sure that you have had your breakfast and are dressed for the day.
2. Prepare yourself a tall glass of water and have a pen and paper, and any other appropriate equipment you might need, ready.
3. Click on the zoom links at the allocated times to join the lesson and your class teacher will admit you to the lesson.
4. During the day it is recommend that you take part in 3 lessons from different subject areas. Here is an example of what a timetable for your day might look like:

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| Lesson 1- zoom and then follow up task. | Wellbeing break | Lesson 2- zoom and then follow up task. | Lunch time | Exercise break | lesson 3- Home Learning- Seesaw. |
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5. We recommend that you break your learning up into small chunks, with lots of time away from your computer screen. Use the learning grids provided by your teacher to guide your choice of lessons. Please build in time to exercise. Try to move around as much as possible, stretching your shoulder and neck muscles often. There are lots of 'at-home' workouts that you can try or try the online workouts by Joe Wicks on Youtube.com.
6. Lastly, make sure you are looking after yourself. Make sure that you have relaxation time and fresh air and we look forward to seeing you in the classroom from home.



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| Monday 18th January | <p>Zoom links are the same as usual and I will send via Ping. Please note there is no expectation to print any work.</p> <p>Please note-one session is pre-recorded to help all children access the lessons and Friday will be a non-screen time day.</p> <p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom</u> English-Poetry-Rhyme. Login to zoom for 9:15 to start the English lesson. We will be reading through a rhyming poem and exploring rhyme. Follow up task-children create their own A-Z rhyming poem.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Zoom</u> Maths-Tally charts Login to zoom for 10:40 and we will answer some questions. Optional follow up task-complete sheet on Seesaw.</p> |
| Tuesday 19th January | <p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom</u> English- Animal rhyming poems. Login to zoom for 9:15 to start the English lesson. Children can help to complete the animal poems by rhyming. Follow up task-children write their own animal rhyming poem and illustrate.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Pre recorded session-White Rose activity-video link below</u> Maths-Pictograms Watch the video link and complete the activity. Please note it suggests going on a walk with family or friends or school friends-this was recorded pre-Covid19 -please stick to current restrictions. | Wednesday 20th January | <p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom.</u> English- Rhyming words. Let's see how many rhyming words we can find together. Follow up-perform their poems they have created this week with actions and expression. Show me on Seesaw if you can.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Zoom</u> Maths-Draw Pictograms. Login to zoom for 10:40 and we will answer questions on Pictograms. Optional follow-up task-Complete sheet on Seesaw.</p> |



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| <p>Thursday 21th January</p> | <p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom</u> English-Phonics and handwriting. Login to zoom for 9:15 to start the lesson. We will be completing the long o sound during the lesson. Optional follow up task-sheet on Seesaw-look at the poster examples for the long o sounds and create your own poster with all the long o sounds and examples of words.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Zoom</u> Maths-Interpret Pictograms. Login to zoom for 10:40 and we will use this session to complete the interpreting pictograms activities. Optional follow up-sheet on Seesaw.</p> |
| <p>Friday 22th January</p> | <p><u>Non- screen day-please note there will no zooms today.</u></p> <p><u>Lesson 1-Create a treasure hunt</u> Create a treasure hunt in the garden or the house for a family member or even your pet! If you are going in the garden, please get permission before you dig anything up to bury the treasure-you can always just hide it. Write instructions and see if they can find the treasure, lead them to different clues you have put around the house/garden, you will need to create a map for them too. Show me what you got up to on Seesaw if you can.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Times tables rap.</u> Create a times tables rap for the 2, 5 or 10 times tables and perform. E.g 1 x 2 is 2, now what ya gonna do, 2 x 2 is 4, now I want more, 3 x 2 is 6 so show me in sticks. You can show me on Seesaw if you like.</p> |
