Remote Learning/ Live Lessons

Monday 22nd February – Friday 26th February

This week, children will have the opportunity to join the live lessons at school from home. Here is a step by step guide for how to schedule your learning and get the most out of this experience.

1. Before you begin your remote education, you should make sure that you have had your breakfast and are dressed for the day.
2. Prepare yourself a tall glass of water and have a pen and paper, and any other appropriate equipment you might need, ready.
3. Click on the zoom links at the allocated times to join the lesson and your class teacher will admit you to the lesson.
4. During the day it is recommend that you take part in 3 lessons from different subject areas. Here is an example of what a timetable for your day might look like:

Lesson 1- zoom and then follow up task.	Wellbeing break	Lesson 2- zoom and then follow up task.	Lunch time	Exercise break	lesson 3- Home Learning- Seesaw.
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5. We recommend that you break your learning up into small chunks, with lots of time away from your computer screen. Use the learning grids provided by your teacher to guide your choice of lessons. Please build in time to exercise. Try to move around as much as possible, stretching your shoulder and neck muscles often. There are lots of 'at-home' workouts that you can try or try the online workouts by Joe Wicks on Youtube.com.
6. Lastly, make sure you are looking after yourself. Make sure that you have relaxation time and fresh air and we look forward to seeing you in the classroom from home.



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Monday	<p>Zoom links are the same as usual and I will send via Ping. Please note there is no expectation to print any work.</p> <p>Please note this week Monday's sessions are pre-recorded and Fridays second session is pre-recorded.</p> <p><u>Lesson 1-Pre-recorded</u> English/Science-Research-Bees. Look out for a Seesaw recorded session and resources on the lifecycle of Honeybees. Create a presentation on the lifecycle of a honeybee. Please stick to the lifecycle as we are doing more general facts tomorrow.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Pre-recorded</u> Maths-2D and 3D shapes. Watch the video and complete the tasks. Tuesday	<p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom</u> English- Honeybees Login to zoom for 9:15 to start the English lesson. Children will need to magpie facts about honeybees from the information and the videos. Maybe a mindmap would be a good idea. Follow up task-children complete their mindmap with their own research.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Zoom</u> Maths-Making 2D and 3D shapes. Login to zoom at 10:40. We will watch the video link and complete the activities. Children need to bring a box if possible, any cube, cuboid, cylinders-any size. Playdough if possible, or salt dough, any colour, any type to make into 3D shapes. Mini-marshmallows or bluetack and straws or lollysticks or pencils. Little objects to put in pens e.g farm animals etc. Do not worry if you don't have everything just bring what you can. https://vimeo.com/506146009</p>
Wednesday	<p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom</u> English- Drama. Login to zoom for 09:15 and we will be doing some Bee drama.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Zoom</u> Maths-Count sides on 2D shapes. Login to zoom for 10:40 and we will answer questions on 2D shapes, Follow-up task-Complete task on Seesaw.</p>



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Thursday	<p><u>Lesson 1-Zoom</u> English-Phonics and handwriting. Login to zoom for 9:15 to start the lesson. We will be completing work on Phase 5 tricky words. Follow up task on Seesaw.</p> <p><u>Lesson 2-Zoom</u> Maths-Count vertices on 2D shapes. Login to zoom for 10:40 and we will use this session to complete the work on 2D shapes. Follow up task on Seesaw.</p>
