



<p>Try and write a mirror message:</p> <div data-bbox="193 1048 1326 1630"><p>1. Write a short message in normal writing (between one to three words is enough). Then hold a mirror at the right hand side of the page, so you can see your message reflected in the mirror.</p><p>2. Copy the message you see in the mirror onto another piece of paper, so that your writing is reversed.</p><p>3. Swap messages with your partner, and hold the mirror at the left hand side of the page. Can you read their message in the mirror?</p><p>4. Think about how the mirrors helped you read the messages.</p></div>
