

#### Remote Learning/ Live Lessons

Monday 11th Jan - Friday 15th Jan

This week, children will have the opportunity to join the live lessons at school from home. Here is a step by step guide for how to schedule your learning and get the most out of this experience.

- 1. Before you begin your remote education, you should make sure that you have had your breakfast and are dressed for the day.
- 2. Prepare yourself a tall glass of water and have a pen and paper, and any other appropriate equipment you might need, ready.
- 3. Click on the zoom links at the allocated times to join the lesson and your class teacher will admit you to the lesson.
- 4. During the day we recommend that you take part in at least 3 lessons from different subject areas each day. Here is an example of what a timetable for your day might look like:

- 5. We recommend that you break your learning up into small chunks, with lots of time away from your computer screen. Use the learning grids provided by your teacher to guide your choice of lessons. - 6. Lastly, make sure you are looking after yourself. Make sure that you have relaxation time and fresh air and we look forward to seeing you in the classroom from home.



Mapping Skills- follow this lesson plan to identify the differences between contrasting places in America.  Learning Sequence  What Do You Think It Looks Like? Ask children to draw or write about a place they know of in North America and a place they know of in South America. How do they differ? Allow children time to share their ideas and discuss with the rest of the class.  Latitude and Longitude: Point out the lines of latitude and longitude on the map. Can children explain what these lines are? (You may wish to revise latitude and longitude with the children here) Discuss the questions on the slide. Can children describe the correlation between the latitude and physical features of a place or region?  Climate Zones: Ask children what they know about the regions marked (revise using Lines of Latitude and Longitude Teaching Pack as necessary).  Key Vocabulary: Children work in pairs to complete the Word Search Activity Sheet then write a definition for each of the key words found. Check that children understand the key terms and are able to confidently describe them.
