As Sports People we can:

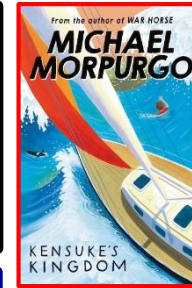
- ✓ Develop Tennis skills with the Sports Coach
