As Sports People we can:

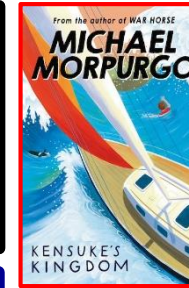
- ✓ Develop football skills with the Sports Coach
