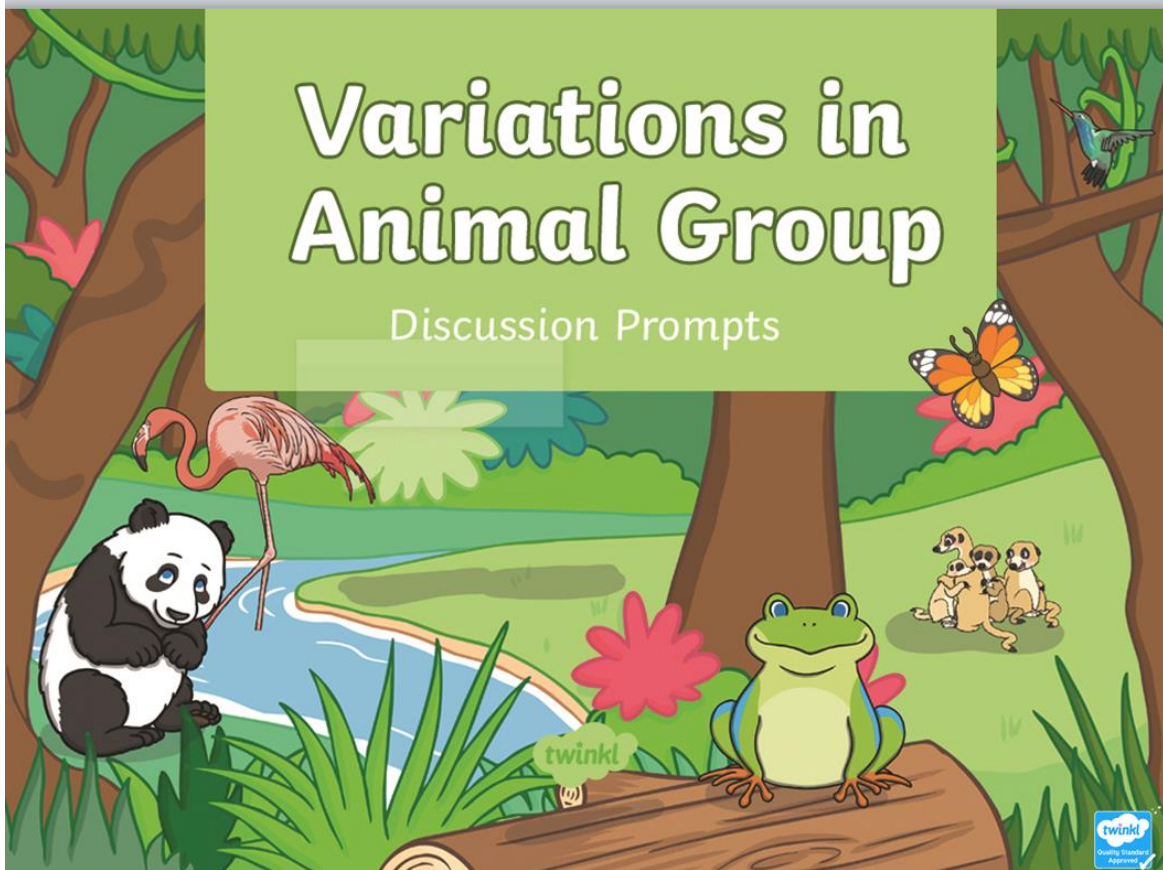


# Variations in Animal Group

## Amphibians

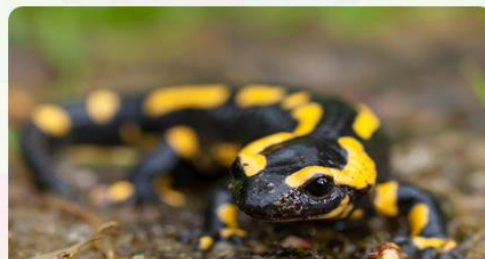


frog
