There are 3 cherries on a cake. Jacob wants to eat 9 cherries. How many cakes must he eat?

Rueben has scored 15 goals in football matches. If he scores 5 goals in each game, how many games does he need to play to score 15 goals?


Lottie has 15 stickers. She shares them equally between 3 of her friends. How many stickers do they get each?


Isla has 16 sweets. She wants to share them between 4 of her friends. How many sweets would they get each?


Matthew has 25p from washing the pots. He gets 5 p each time he does it. How many times has he washed the pots?
