<p>Topic</p>	<p>What happened to the dinosaurs?</p> <p>Here are some ideas for you to complete at home whilst you are self isolating this week. Please upload anything you complete to Seesaw so we can see all the amazing things you are doing at home.</p>	
<p>Literacy</p>	<p>Watch the 'Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs' video Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs - Give Us A Story - YouTube.</p> <p>Using the picture from the book (see attached), write down as many adjectives as you can to describe the dinosaurs.</p> <p>We will use these in our Zoom lesson on Thursday.</p>	<p>Create your own dinosaur. Give your dinosaur a name and write some sentences to describe it.</p> <p>Remember to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Capital letters - Full stops - Finger spaces - Adjectives
<p>Handwriting</p>	<p>Practise writing the letters v, s and r using the attached handwriting sheets.</p>	
<p>Maths and Problem Solving</p>	<p>Look at the ordering numbers lesson Aut1.12.4 - Order numbers on Vimeo</p> <p>Complete the ordering numbers worksheet. You might want to make the numbers practically with household objects to help you.</p>	<p>Complete the numbers to 20 assessment. Try to get your child to do this independently.</p>
<p>Science and the outside environment</p>	<p>Using the Seasons powerpoints, ask the children which season they think it is and why.</p>	



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<p>Humanities and Citizenship</p>	<p>Look at the Christians pictures PowerPoint. Who do you think the pictures are about? Why do you think they are about that person? Draw a picture of what you think a Christian would look like and write a sentence to explain why.</p>	
<p>Creative Arts</p>	<p>Draw a picture of your favourite dinosaur. Think about the thickness of the lines, can you make some of the lines thicker than others for effect? There are lots of videos on Youtube to help you with your drawings if you wanted to use them. E.g. How to Draw a T-Rex Dinosaur Easy - YouTube</p>	
<p>Physical Education</p>	<p>Practise your ball skills. How many times can you throw and catch a ball without dropping it? Have another go, can you beat your score? Try throwing and catching with a partner - can you do 20 catches without dropping the ball? (If you don't have a ball, you could use a rolled up pair of socks.)</p>	
<p>Reading and phonics</p>	<p>Practise your reading books and phonics cards.</p>	<p>Go on Phonics Games for the Classroom and Home - Phonics Bloom and practise either the phase 3 or phase 4 games.</p>
<p>Times tables</p>	<p>Practise your number bonds to 10. Farmer Pete song with animation by Sunshine Class (pupils aged 5 years) - YouTube See attached number bonds document.</p>
