<b>Topic</b>	Where will your powers take you? Here are some ideas for you to complete at home whilst you are self isolating this week.
<b>Literacy and Communication</b>	Watch the video of the Supertato story. Try to include capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and adjectives.
<b>Maths and Problem Solving</b>	Watch our number bonds song video <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=poJmS5iWfEs">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=poJmS5iWfEs</a>  Complete the attached white rose maths worksheet to practise your number bonds to 10.
<b>Science and the outside environment</b>	Complete a sink or float experiment.  Find a range of items around your house and predict whether you think the item will sink or float. Carry out the investigation and record your results using the attached sheets.
<b>Creative Arts</b>	Design your own superhero cape.  Be as creative as you like, you can use colours, paint, collage etc.
<b>Physical Education</b>	Practise your ball skills: Can you roll a ball to a partner 10 times? Can you throw and catch a ball 10 times without dropping it? Can you throw a ball at a target? (Your target could be a bowl or the laundry basket).  If you don't have a ball you could use a rolled up pair of socks.
<b>Reading and phonics</b>	Practise your reading book at home.  Log onto Teach Your Monster to Read to practise your phonics skills. This is a free website or there is an app but it costs.
