
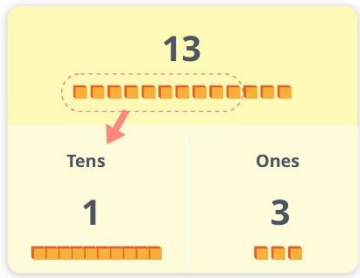

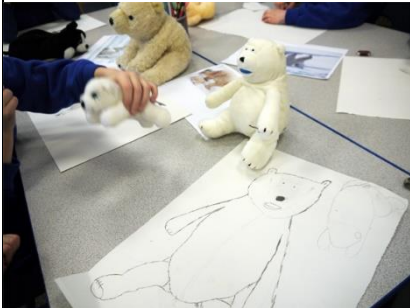

Topic	Tremendous Toys: Have you got this toy at home? Here are some ideas for you to complete at home whilst you are in lockdown this week.
