Literacy and Communication	<p>Complete after Monday's Zoom lesson:</p> <p>Miss Mainprize is going to share with you the story Potion Commotion.</p> <p>Use the attached sheet to write a list of ingredients you would put into your own potion. Try to use adjectives to describe what you are putting in, e.g. smelly socks, rotten eyeballs</p>	Create your own acrostic Halloween poem. Maths and Problem Solving	<p>Using teddies/lego/another object to show $3+5 = 8$. Now work out $5+3$. What do you notice about the answer? Repeat for other calculations does this always work?</p> <p>Complete White Rose Maths Addition Fact Families sheet.</p> <p>Challenge: Shape addition</p>	<p>Using a piece of paper split in half, how many ways can you show that make 7? Try to be systematic about this:</p> <p>$0+7=7$ $1+6=7$ $2+5=7$ $3+3=7$ $4+3=7$ $5+2=7$ $6+1=7$ $7+0=7$</p> <p>Complete White Rose Maths Systematic Number bonds sheet.</p>	
Science and the outside environment	<p>Last week you did the floating and sinking experiment and everyone found that objects made from metal sunk.</p> <p>Boats are made from metal but they float. Why do metal ships float?</p> <p>Research what the first boat looked like and how boats have changed over time.</p> <p>Make your own boat. Use the results from your experiment last week to choose materials that you think will make the boat float, e.g. a plastic bottle boat, a raft made of twigs and sticks. Test your boat to see if it floats. If it doesn't, how could you change your design to make your boat float?</p>		
Humanities and Citizenship	<p><u>Black History Month</u></p> <p>Research one of these famous black people. Discuss with your family how black people used to be treated very different to white people.
