

Make a bottle bird feeder

Here's a neat thing for you to make... and the birds will like it too. Provide pencil perches for the perfect hanging feeder.

- 1** Cut pin-sized holes in the bottom of the bottle to let any water drain away.



- 2** Make holes on either side of the bottle, so you can thread your pencils or spoons through.
- 3** Cut an extra flap 3 cm long just above the top of each hole and push it inwards. This will allow birds to reach the seed, and stop rain getting in.



You will need

- Drinks or milk bottle
- Scissors
- String
- Pencils or wooden spoons
- Birdseed

- 4** Fill up the bottle with birdseed.



- 5** Screw on the bottle lid and tie the string around the neck of the bottle. Now hang your feeder up for hungry birds.
