At Broadbent Fold we continue to provide a rich and broad curriculum, which meets the needs of all our children and prepares them for their future. This term has been packed:

EYFS – Read Dear Zoo and had a fabulous visit from some zoo friends. Take a look at our school blog for more pictures. Year 1 – Have been learning about planting and the importance of growing our own. They looked after the seeds and the shoots have grown so high. Well done Year 1. Year 2 – Have been learning about the importance of bees.



They have been planting to encourage bees to our school and have done an



excellent job at the side of Year 2 classroom. Year 3 – Have been enjoying their work on The Iron Man. They loved the book and wrote some excellent plans to capture it too. Year 4 – Have gone Tudor crazy this half term and are so knowledgeable about this period in history. They made some Tudor

ATTENDANCE
