Draw around yourself and label as many different parts of the body as you can.



Measure the length of 5 objects in your house using household objects such as pasta/toy cars/paper clips,



e.g. the pencil is 5 paper clips long

Which is the longest/shortest?

Challenge: Can you measure the length of them using a ruler (to the nearest cm)?



Use your art skills to create a dinosaur (2D or 3D). You can be as creative as you like: paint a picture, collage, use paper plates, playdough etc.



Research and create a factfile for your favourite dinosaur. You could include its name, a picture, what it looked like, what it ate, how big it was etc.



Write 4 sentences using the conjunction 'but' to compare things you and your family like. The things should be different but about the same topic. Each side of the 'but' should be a sentence.

E.g. I like chocolate but my Dad likes sweets.

There blands hair but my

I have blonde hair but my Mum has brown hair.
