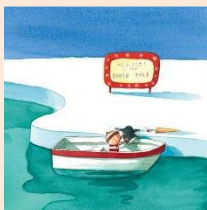


Write 4 sentences to compare Africa and the South Pole. Try to use and/but to extend your sentences.



Share a packet of sweets equally between you and your teddy bears. Can you write a number sentence to show what you have done? E.g.  $20 \div 5 = 4$ . Repeat 6 times with a different number of sweets/teddy bears.



Create a hot or cold scene in a shoe box.



Choose 5 different items from around your house, e.g. plate, straw, paper, cake, apple etc. Can you cut them into half? Can you cut them into quarters? Can you show  $\frac{3}{4}$ ?



Create arrays using play dough or toys for the following:

$6 \times 2 =$	$7 \times 3 =$
$3 \times 5 =$	$2 \times 7 =$
$2 \times 10 =$	$4 \times 6 =$
$4 \times 4 =$	$3 \times 4 =$
